## **crime statistics / police report >>>**

The following crime report covers the entire suburb of Jindalee for the April - May period:

- 4/04/2023 - Between 8:30pm and 12am a home in Cowangah Street was entered via an unlocked door. Motor vehicle stolen. Vehicle has been recovered.
- 5/04/2023 - At approximately 1:30am a store in Loranah Street Shops broken into and cash stolen. One offender has been arrested.
- 10/04/2023 - Between 5:45pm and 5:55pm a bird bath was stolen from a home in Mount Ommaney Drive.
- 14/04/2023 - At approximately 2am a home in Mukine Street had front door tampered with. Nil entry - just damage to front door lock.
- 15/05/2023 - At approximately 9:30pm a resident in Mukine Street observed two females on their Ring camera door bell enter their garage area. Turned on outside light and females left the yard. Later discovered that an unlocked vehicle had been entered and property stolen. Most likely linked to below offence.
- 15/05/2023 - Between 9:30pm and 10:30pm a home in Chipala Street entered via unlocked back door. A vehicle was stolen (Silver Toyota Camry). Vehicle has not been recovered at this time - was used in Fuel stealing offence in Wacol.
- 16/05/2023 - Between 3:30am and 3:50am a home in Mt Ommaney Drive was entered via unlocked rear door. Keys stolen and used to steal a vehicle parked in driveway. Vehicle has been recovered.
- 16/05/2023 - Between 12am and 5am a car in driveway in Mt Ommaney Drive had window smashed and property stolen.
- 16/05/2023 - At approximately 5:30am a resident disturbed a male person in front yard of home in Kangaloon Street. Male fled but dropped a car key. Most likely the same offenders as above offence in Mt Ommaney Drive.
- 22/05/2023 - At approximately 12:30am a resident has disturbed a male person attempting to open a door of home in Millewa Close. Offenders have attempted to open four doors at the home. Offenders have run away.
